

Program Snapshot



About the program:

The New Jersey Youth Corps of Phillipsburg is Warren County's only full-time service and conservation corps. Founded in May of 1998, we provide municipal support to the Town of Phillipsburg & Warren County providing



hundreds of youth the opportunity to earn their High School Equivalency (HSE) while providing valuable services to their community. Funded through the New Jersey Department of Labor & Workforce Development, the Youth Corps is a 'second-chance' program for young adults aged 16-25 that did not complete high school. Through a balance of academics and Service Learning, we provide the foundation upon which to build a brighter future. To date, we have assisted 435 young men and women in obtaining their High School Eqivalency.

Over the last 21 years at NJ Youth Corps of Phillipsburg, **1,070 individuals** have performed **277,023 hours** of service opportunities with an educational component – **service valued at \$7.7 million*!** Environmentally themed service projects have predominated. It has led us to develop partnerships with the Warren County Dept. of Land Preservation (<u>landscaping & Trail construction/maintenance</u>) and the NJ Audubon (<u>ecological/habitat restorations</u>) – the latter of which is bolstered by a <u>credentialed training program</u> providing introductory lessons on habitat restoration and worksite safety instruction. We've even delved into the realm of Historic Preservation, being <u>recognized nationally</u> for restoring the Park HQ Porch at Gateway National Recreation Area's Sandy Hook Unit!



We engage in these projects so that Corpsmembers can feel a sense of personal and civic pride but also to demonstrate the metaphoric aspect of the work; that bad practices can be corrected and damage can be undone. The work also demonstrates that these processes take time. Much like the changes our Corpsmembers must make in their lives, the impact of their experience —and the resultant effects of their work - cannot be overstated. As a member Corps in the 21st Century Conservation Service Corps (21CSC) and with the support of the Corps Network, we hope to provide pathways to careers in the

environmental field, building on a foundation of education and service - toward a lifetime of sustainability.

Program Statistics:

- Enroll 40 Opportunity Youth annually
- 85% successfully complete program
- 90% of completers obtain at least 1 form of Positive Outcome (HS Diploma, Employment, OJT, etc.)
- Program Participants collectively provide over 7,000 hours of service valued at over \$200,000 annually.
- Corpsmembers also receive personal and career counseling while enrolled.
